The successful candidate will join us on a permanent basis working 9.5 hours a week over 3 days, of which the days can be flexible and will be discussed as a part of the interview process. The role is made of face-to-face groups in Trowbridge and Melksham and an online Evening Group. The successful candidate will also be expected to attend the office, once a week in order to complete administration tasks and build relationships with the wider team.

Our services are accessible for everybody in our community, and we provide one-to-one counselling support for people who are experiencing mental health problems including adults and Children and Young People from 11+. Previous experience in group support is essential, as is a passion for the work of our charity in supporting people who are experiencing mental health problems.
